Excellence


In our office we have an area where we proudly display student work on an 'Excellent' standard.

Our Year 4 - 8 students recently sat the STAR test (Student Test of Achievement in Reading). It tests vocab knowledge, comprehension and word meanings.

The score they get is equal to a stanine level eg: Stanine 9 = superior

7, 8 - Above average

4, 5, 6 - Average

2, 3 - Below Average

1 - Requires Support

They sit the test again in November and hopefully they show gains in their scores.

I've told our tamariki the best way to increase their score is to put in the mileage. Like anything, the more you do, the better you get at it.
